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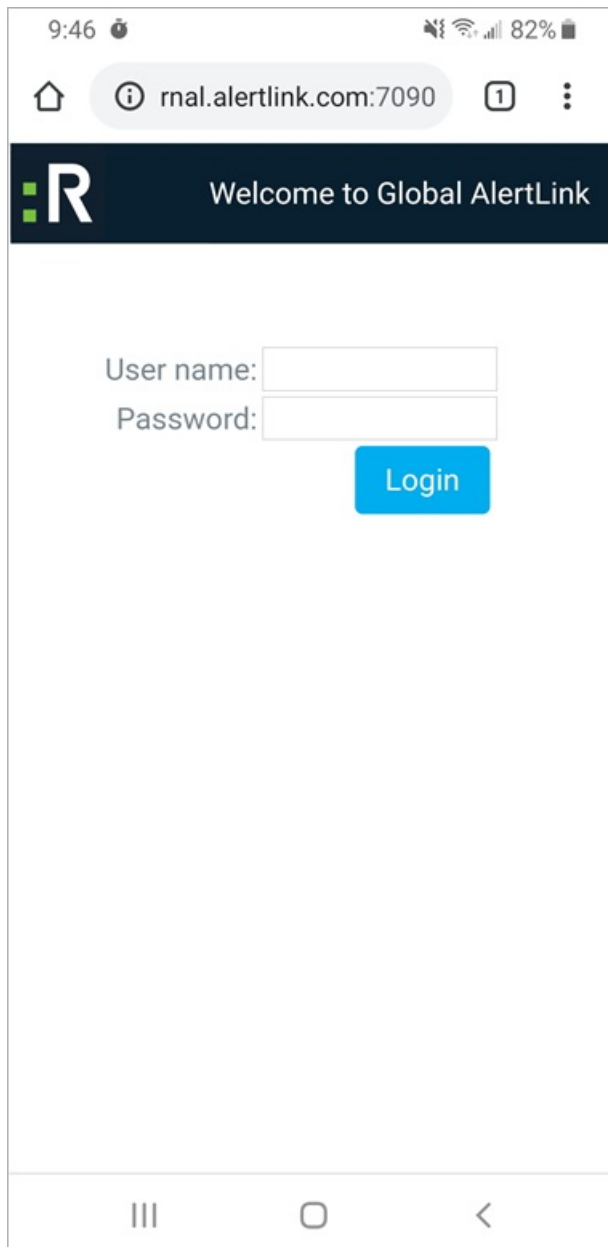
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Mobile Web Application

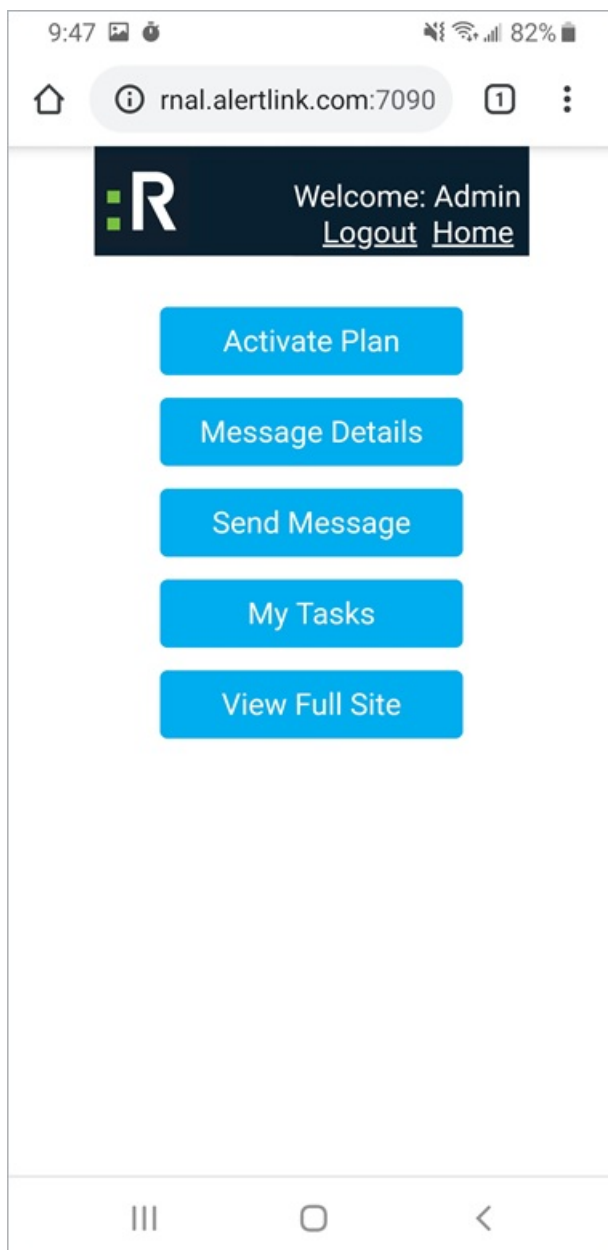

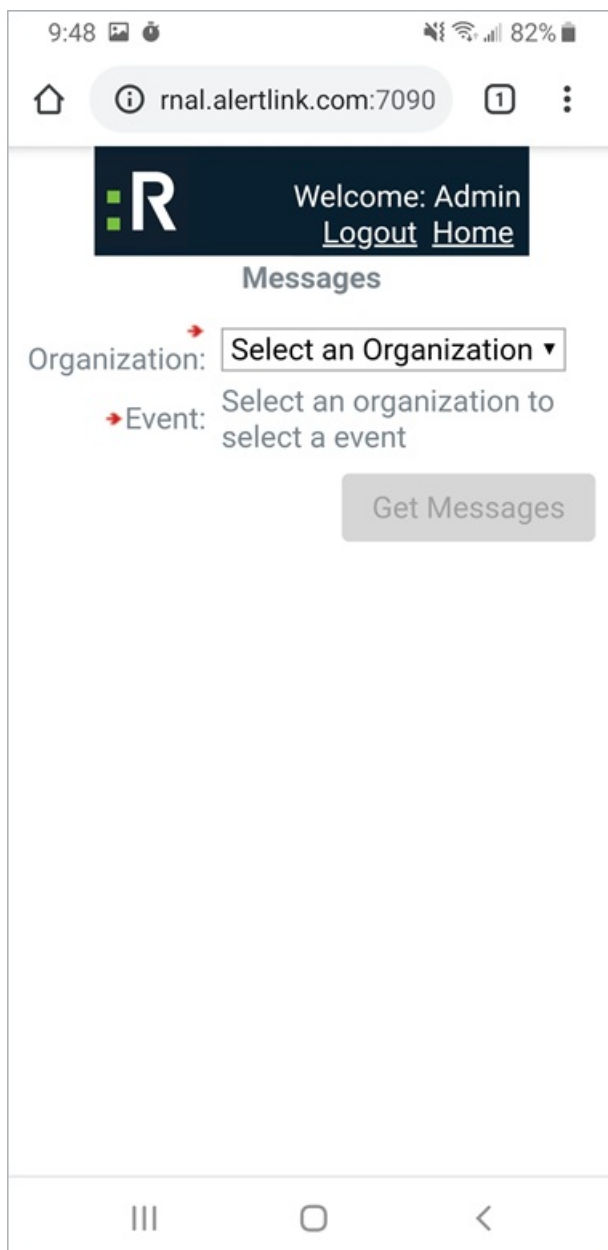

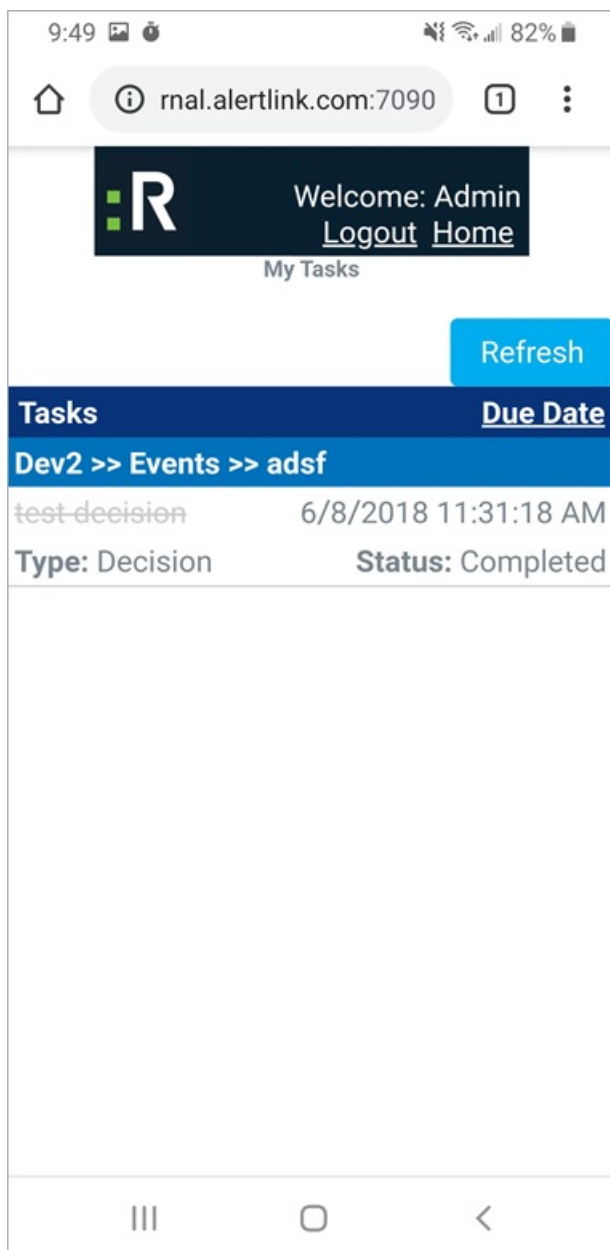

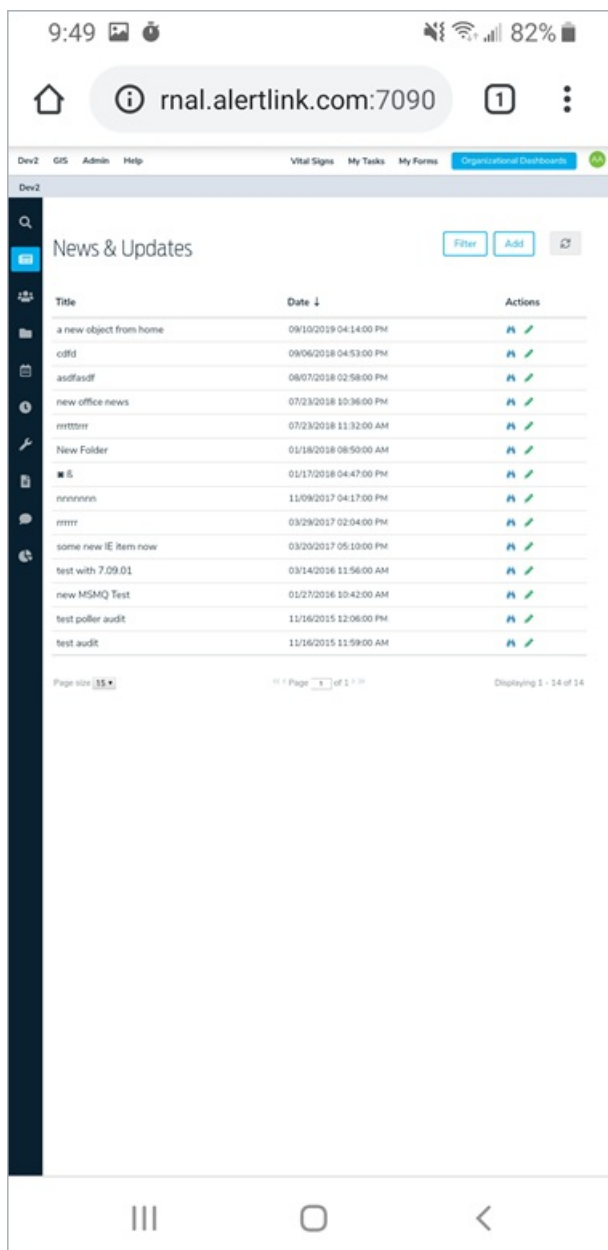
This page allows users to view the tasks that have been assigned to them.
